Ground Transportation

Attendees are responsible for their own ground transportation while in Washington, D.C. Some events are within walking distance of each other. At other times, attendees may choose to share a cab, take the bus, or ride the Metro.

Metro Directions to the Washington Court Hotel from Reagan National: Take the yellow line (toward Fort Totten) to the China Town Metro Station or the blue line (toward Largo Town Center) to Metro Center.
