1. *The job is not done.* Although there has been some progress on the aviation and surface transportation bills, no long-term legislation has been enacted. These programs are operating under the latest of what has been a series of short-term continuing resolutions – 22 for aviation and eight for highways and transit programs.
2. *Not all spending is the same.* With last summer's debt deal and the subsequent downgrading of U.S. debt, there will be an even greater tendency by some legislators to view all spending the same – unnecessary. Our charge is to illustrate that maintaining and upgrading our transportation infrastructure is a blue chip investment and absolutely necessary for continued economic recovery.
3. *Out of sight, out of mind.* Next year will be a crazy political year by any standard. It will be easy for Congress to go into campaign mode and push off any complicated legislative issues until after the election. However, Wisconsin can't wait. Harbors will still need to be dredged, roads built and passengers transported. Let's help the Wisconsin delegation keep Wisconsin moving.

Please join the TDA Fly-in to thank members for their work, and to encourage them to strengthen Wisconsin's infrastructure, a building block for future prosperity.
